Side Tilt Carriages

There are 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been uniform.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is approximately thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted forks differ by the amount of offset between the blade and the blade eye. Different makers will differ the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
